

SSDC Services

If you are unable to work full-time because of an illness, injury or medical condition and you are not yet retirement age, you may be eligible for Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI) benefits.

The Association is partnering with SSDC Services Corp., a national advocacy firm specializing in SSDI benefits and Medicare coordination. SSDC Services is offering Association members, family and friends SSDI representation at a discounted rate.

The main qualifications for SSDI are:

- *You have worked 5 of the last 10 years and paid FICA taxes*
- *You're diagnosed with a disabling medical condition expected to last at least 12 months or result in death*
- *You're a U.S. Citizen or lawfully admitted resident of the U.S. between the ages of 18 and 64*
- *You're unable to do the work you previously did and are unable to find new work because of your medical condition*
- *Visit the Social Security Administration for a full list of qualifying conditions, or take our simple assessment survey to find out if you qualify for SSDI. Our representatives will make sure to get you the help you need.*

What do they do?

SSDC identifies whether you or your dependents are eligible for SSDI benefits and early Medicare, and becomes your advocate for filing and obtaining these benefits. SSDC is a national advocacy firm with 40 years of experience, over 100,000 SSDI awards and a 98% satisfaction rate from our customers.

Why SSDI?

SSDI can provide disabled individuals an increased monthly income, early eligibility for Medicare benefits, additional dependent benefits and more.

Why is early Medicare important?

Healthcare premiums typically drop when you enroll in Medicare. Medicare plan enrollees can have lower out-of-pocket costs when you see doctors or other providers.

The Social Security Administration allows attorneys or firms to charge 25% of awarded retroactive benefits up to \$6,000. SSDC is offering Association members, family and friends a discounted rate no higher than **20% or \$4,000** of awarded retroactive benefits. When you contact us, ask about your discounted rate. **There are no fees unless you are awarded SSDI benefits.**
